### 04. -27. August 2023 The papier & klang Festival by Haus des Papiers in *Die Möglichkeit einer Insel*

With the opening event on August 3rd, the Museum Haus des Papiers celebrates its third exhibition as part of the papier & klang festival. Raw concrete meets delicate paper textures within the project space *Die Möglichkeit einer Insel*. Objects, video, and sound installations reveal in-between spaces and states as well as intermediary sounds to be experienced with or through paper. The works of eight artists will be on display.

After the exhibitions at the **Freundeskreis Willy-Brandt-Haus e.V.** and the **Museum für Kommunikation Berlin**, Haus des Papiers will be celebrating papier & klang festival's third exhibition opening on Thursday, 3 August at 6 p.m.

The thematic focus concerning the artistic exploration of paper as a material in relationship to inner or audible sounds finds its space here as well.

Curved paper strips by Gabriela Stellino create spaces and interstices, Harriet Groß's fine, almost organic paper funnels blur the border between linearity and spatiality. Mark Schreiber transferred Franz Mons' reading book first into sound and then into collages, Solveig Gubser captures colourful intermediate tones in paper ink, and Rachel de Jooode dedicates herself to the physical and emotional borderline experience of breastfeeding with milk cartons.

The interplay between inside and outside is reflected by Claudia Hajek, who exposes paper to the influences of nature in her video installation, as well as Janine Eggert's and Renata Palekcić's self-developed spatial installation. Their paper cocoon reacts to the physical proximity of visitors with sounds and noises that intensify inside it.

The exhibition in *Die Möglichkeit einer Insel* runs from the 4<sup>th</sup> til 27<sup>th</sup> August. The project space at Inselstraße 7, 10179 Berlin, is always open from Friday to Sunday with free admission.
