Haus des Papiers opens its  
fourth and last exhibition as  
part of the festival papier &  
klang by Haus des Papiers  
2023. In addition to the  
current exhibition  
"Embossed and Tossed",  
works by Barbara  
Beisinghoff, Donna Fei, Kaja  
Ev el Attar as well as record  
covers and sound  
recordings by Joseph Beuys  
will be presented.**

After the exhibitions at the Freundeskreis Willy-Brandt-Haus e.V., Museum für Kommunikation Berlin, and Die Möglichkeit einer Insel, Haus des Papiers welcomes the art festival in its own rooms on Thursday, August 10<sup>th</sup>, with an opening exhibition at 6 pm. The museum is the last station of its own festival and will partake in it until September 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Speaking through and with paper, communication within family structures captured in paper, or raising a political voice and the connection of art and politics by means of this medium, create the thematic connection of the exhibited positions, which can be traced back to the human capacity for language.

Barbara Beisinghoff lets her thoughts flow through her water jet into the paper, even before they sound like an actual spoken language, light-glyph paintings emerging from it in this way. Donna Fei describes her approach as an interaction of the material with her own thoughts, treating it as a conversation between herself and the paper. Kaja Ev el Attar questions and investigates the constellations within her family. Joseph Beuys' record covers illustrate the political dimension of artistic interventions in which the contentious artist used paper as a medium for political messages in record covers as well as in posters.

The exhibition Haus des Papiers, Seydelstraße 30, 10117 Berlin, will be open from August 11th to September 3rd. Regular admission is 8.50 €, reduced admission 6 €.
